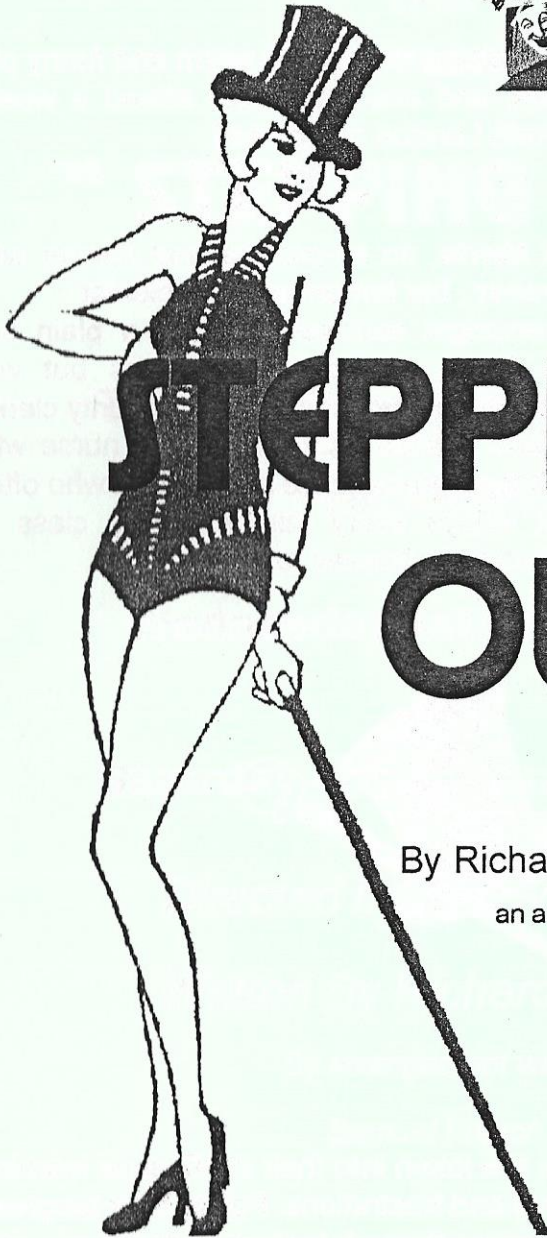

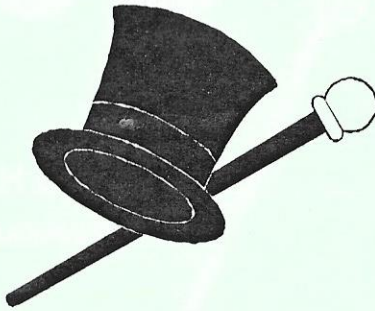

ABOUT STEPPING OUT

Stepping Out, written by Richard Harris, is a warm and funny play about a group of women, and one man, who attend a weekly tap-dancing class in a North London church hall.

The characters include **Mavis**, an ex-professional dancer who runs the class - **Mrs Fraser**, her temperamental pianist - **Sylvia** a cheerfully overweight extrovert - **Andy** a plain self conscious do-gooder - **Vera**, snobby and tactless but well meaning - **Dorothy**, timid but enthusiastic Social Security clerk - **Maxine** flashy, sharp and shrewd - **Lynne** a quiet nurse who loves to dance - **Rose** happy-go-luck wife and mother who often gets things wrong, but enjoys every minute of the class - **Geoffrey**, a widower who keeps himself to himself.



As the story unfolds you are taken into their confidence learning about their hopes, dreams and frustrations. Follow their progress from uncoordinated beginners through to their performance of a "big tap number" in a Grand Charity Gala.
