

LIONEL BART (1930-1999), the youngest of twelve children, was born Lionel Begleiter - he took the name Bart from St Bartholomews "Barts" hospital. His Jewish family settled in the East End of London. after escaping the pogroms in Austria. When he was six a teacher told his parents he was a musical genius and so they gave him a violin and paid for lessons but

he didn't practice so they were stopped. At 16 he wanted to be an artist and won a scholarship to St Martins School of Art but was expelled for 'mischievousness' and eventually drifted back to music.

Like Irving Berlin Bart couldn't read music but that didn't stop him. Before writing musicals he was busy in the 'pop' world, he discovered Tommy Steel and wrote hits for him and Cliff Richards. Between 1957 -1960 he won 9 Ivor Novello Awards and a Variety Club Silver Heart.

His most successful musical was "Oliver" which opened June 1960. He followed this with "Blitz!" and so had two hit musicals running in the West End - no mean feat! His last hit was "Maggie".

Despite Bart's later failures Andrew Lloyd Webber has hailed him as "the father of the modern British musical" not a bad epitaph for a poor East End boy.
